### Description

### Exam conditions

All trainees need to pass a final exam in order to complete the security course. The minimum pass grade is 60%. If a trainee fails for the first time, he/she will be given a second attempt at the exam. If a trainee fails twice, he/she will have to retake the entire course.

## Certification

Once the trainee has passed the final exam, he/she will be provided with a e-Certificate that can be printed. The certificate is then valid for 60 months at all airports of the Swiss Confederation.
